

# Haywood - Hobart



Can anyone shed some light on the origins of this bell which has the names 'Haywood' and 'Hobart' cast into its top? The staple is not original and it covers parts of the lettering. It is probable that the bell had a single post staple when it was manufactured.



Our searching has only revealed a firm by the name of C. D. Haywood Pty Ltd, which was established in 1875 - a company specialising in the production of biscuits. In 1950 it was absorbed by Swallow and Ariel, and later Arnotts.
